Dear Environmental Health Customer:

This letter is written to inform you of an important policy change for the Clayton County Board of Health, Environmental Health Services unit. This change affects how payments are received for Food Service Applications and Permits, Tourist Accommodations, Septic Tank Permits, Public Pool Permits and all other services licensed or permitted through the Board of Health.

A change in policy of the Clayton County Board of Health now requires that **all permits, application fees, inspection fees, and penalty fees be paid in the form of check (personal or business) or money order.** Effective immediately, we will no longer accept cash as a form of payment. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, but ask that you plan accordingly to present the correct form(s) of payment at the time fees are due.
