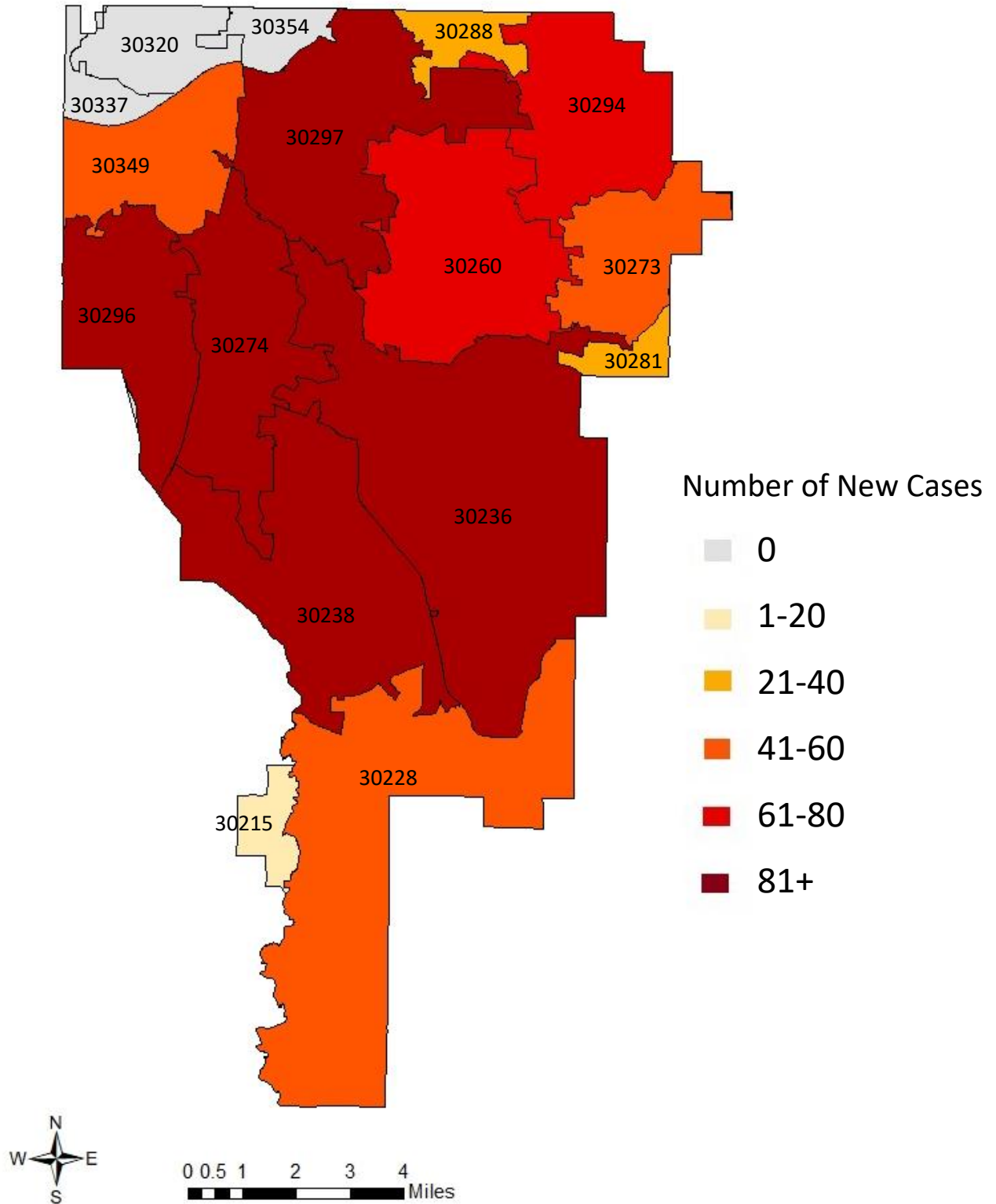


Clayton County, Georgia New COVID-19 Cases From 8/30- 9/05, 2021





COVID-19 SUMMARY REPORT FOR CLAYTON COUNTY

- As of September 05, 2021, Clayton County has 30,662 cases of 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) and 551 confirmed deaths.
- There were 881 new Positive COVID-19 tests reported in Clayton County from 8/30 - 9/05.
- Clayton County accounts for 2.7% of the total cases in Georgia.
- 5.6% of the positive cases in Clayton County have been hospitalized and 1.8% of positive cases in Clayton County have died.
- The average percent of Positive PCR tests in Clayton County over the last 7 days is 14%.
- The total number of confirmed cases (PCR) per 100,000 people in Clayton County is 9,969.
- The total number of cases (PCR and Antigen) per 100,000 people in Clayton County is 11,170.
- In Clayton County 119,578 residents (42%) have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine and 101,973 (36%) have been fully vaccinated.

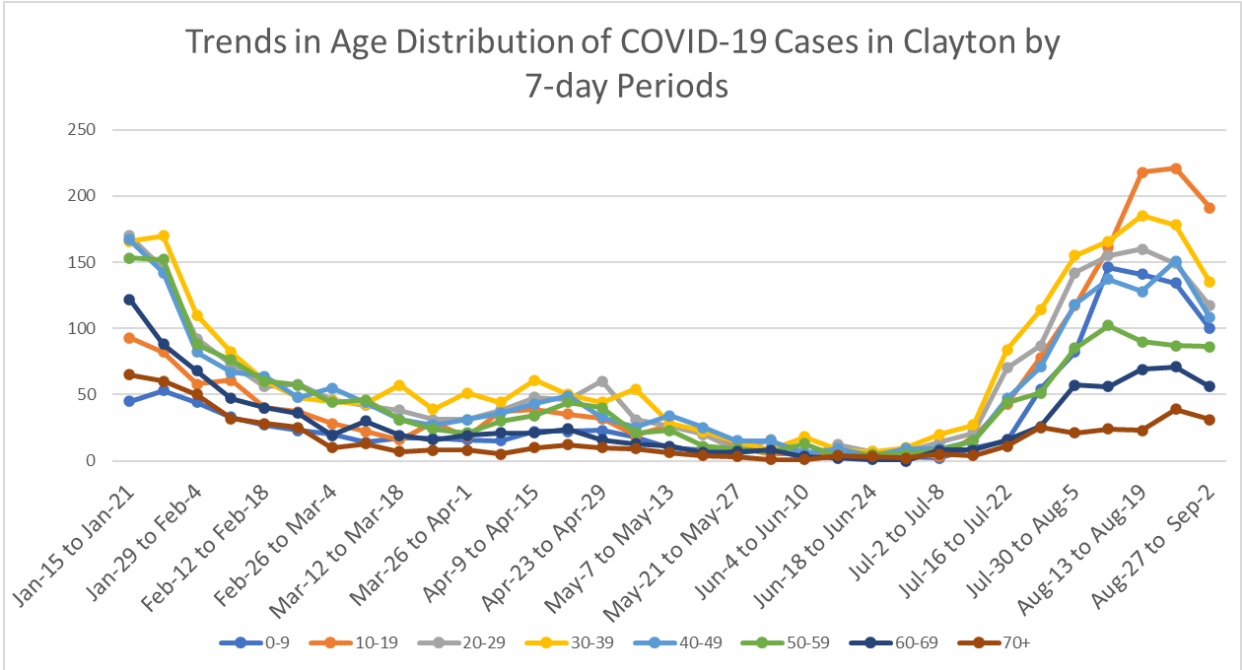

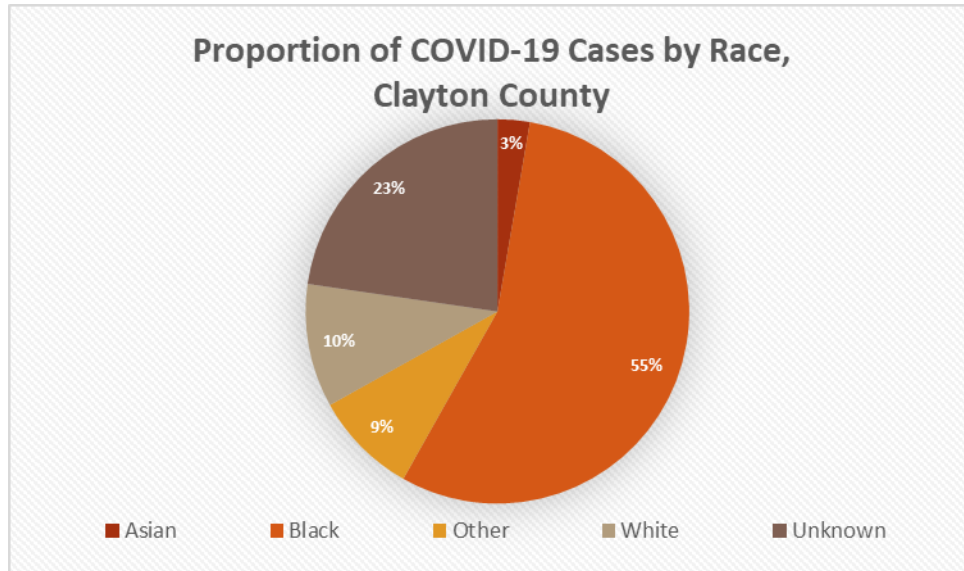

GRAPH 1. DISTRIBUTION OF POSITIVE CASES BY AGE OVER 7-DAY PERIODS

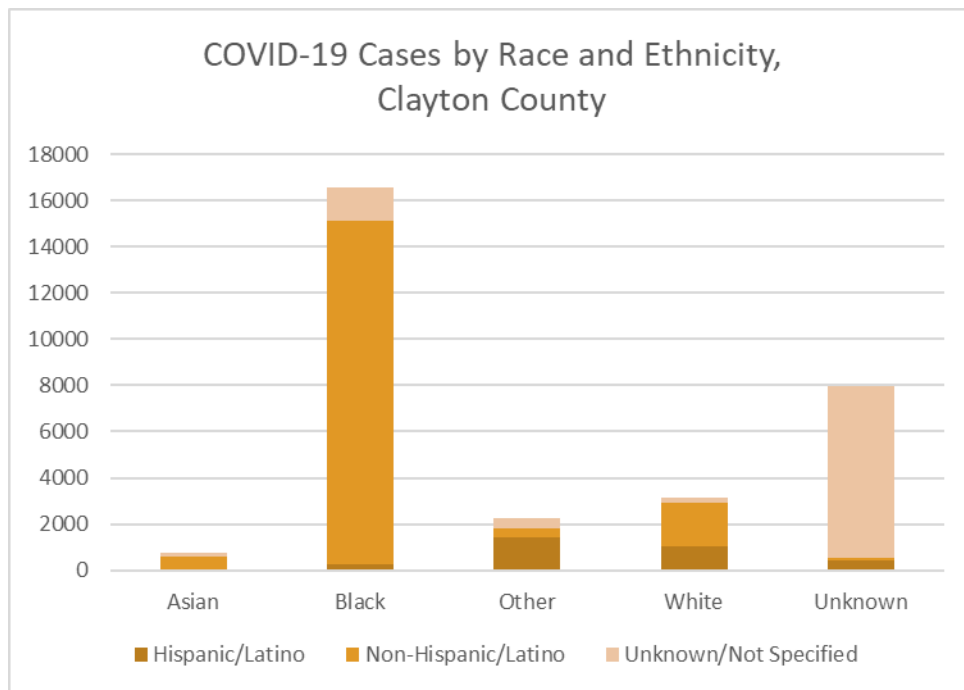

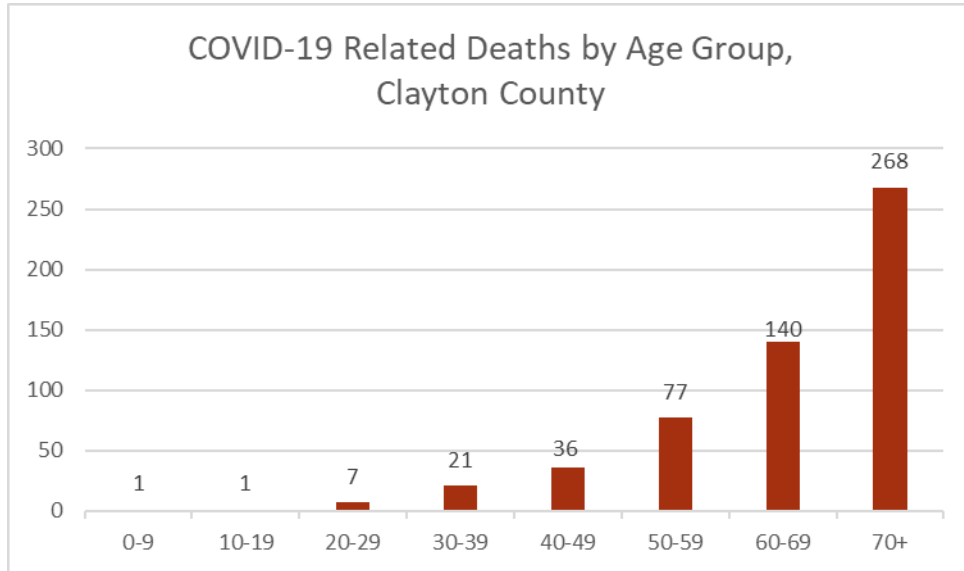
GRAPH 2. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 CASES BY RACE IN CLAYTON COUNTY

GRAPH 5. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 RELATED DEATHS BY RACE AND ETHNICITY IN CLAYTON COUNTY

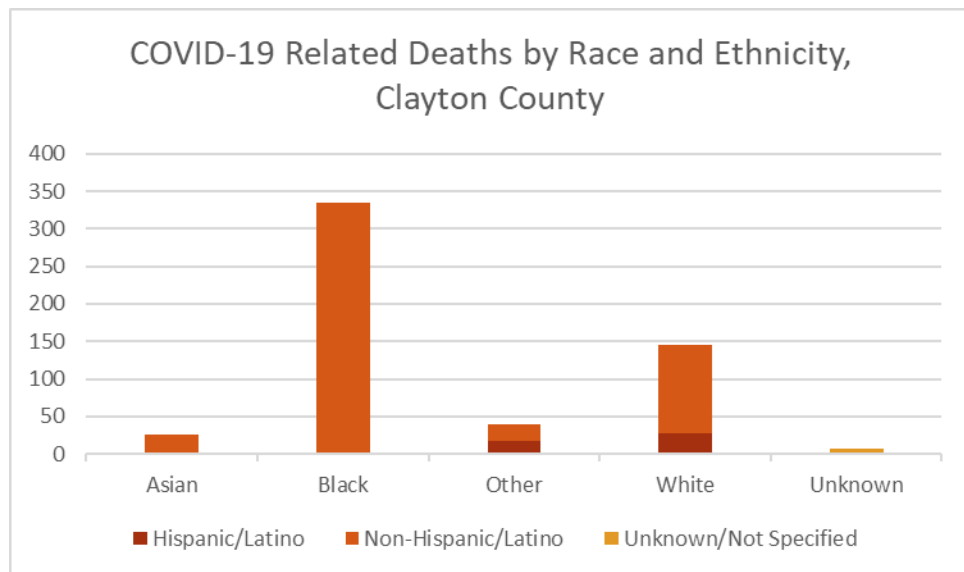


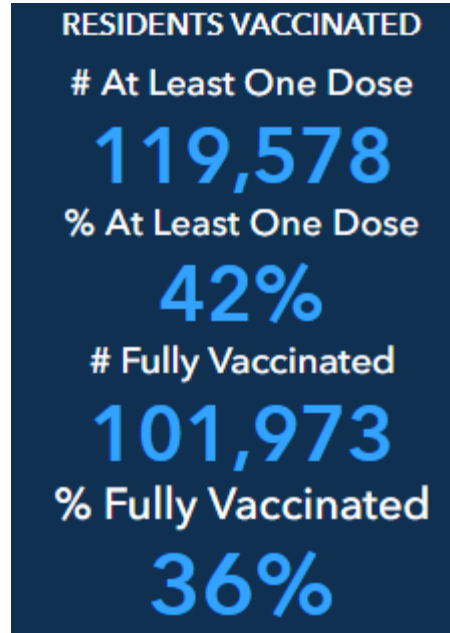
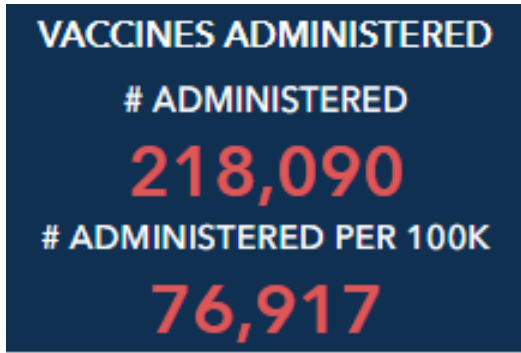

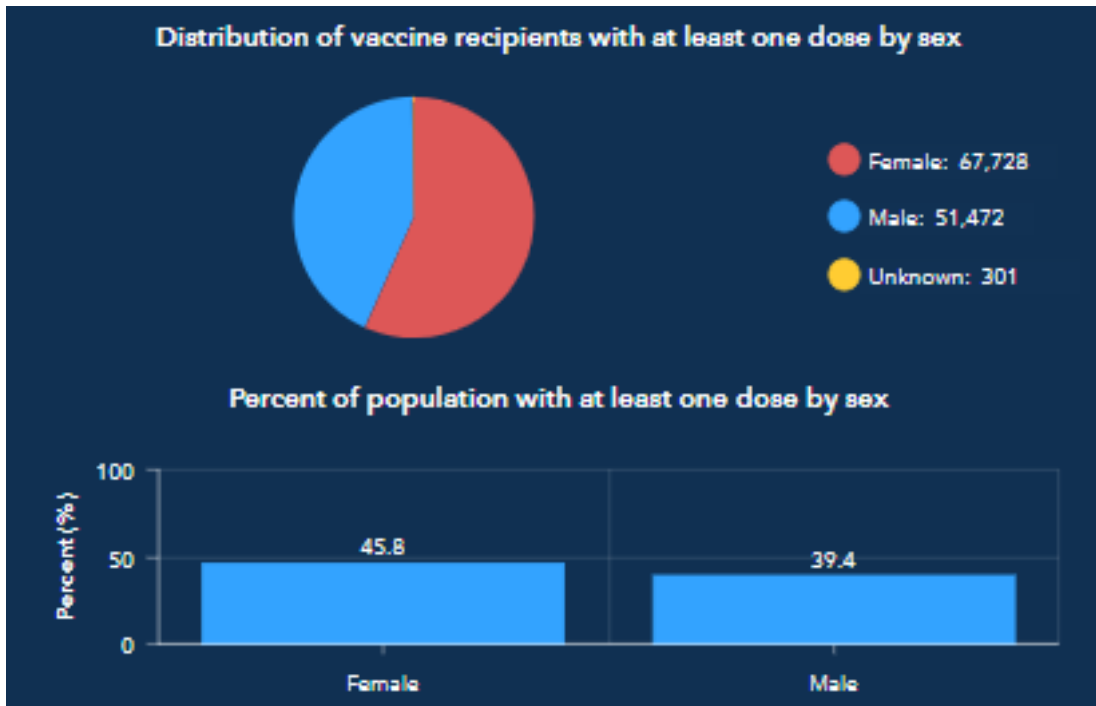

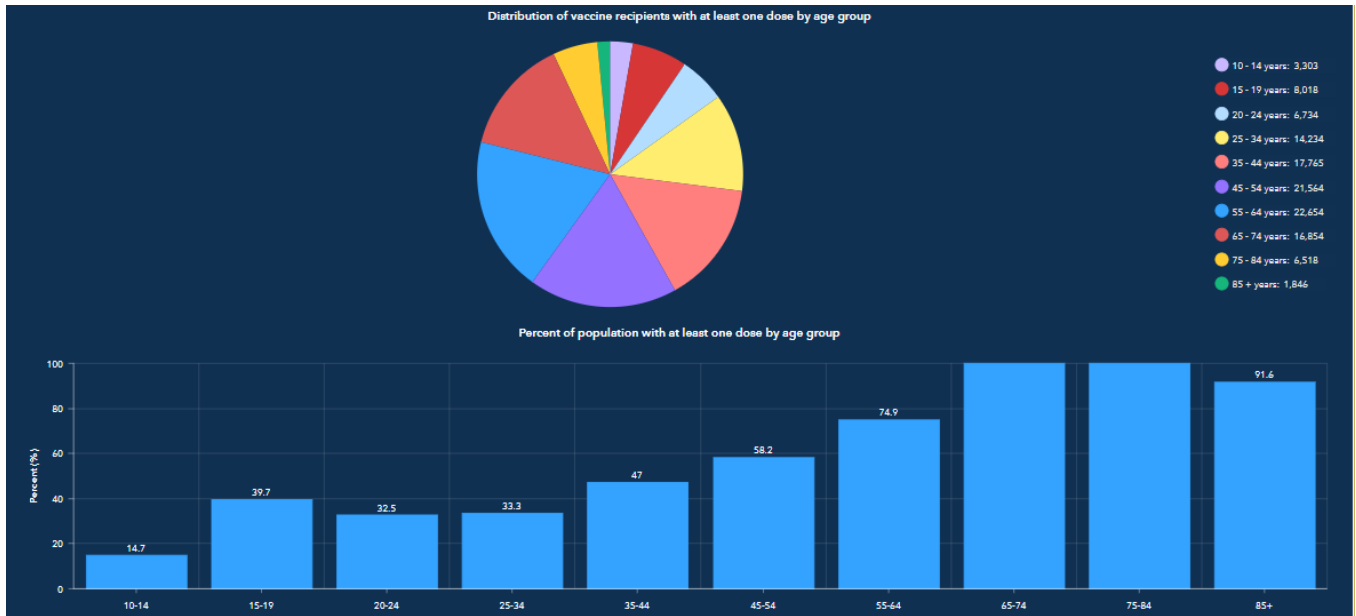
CLAYTON COUNTY VACCINE NUMBERS AS OF 9/05/2021



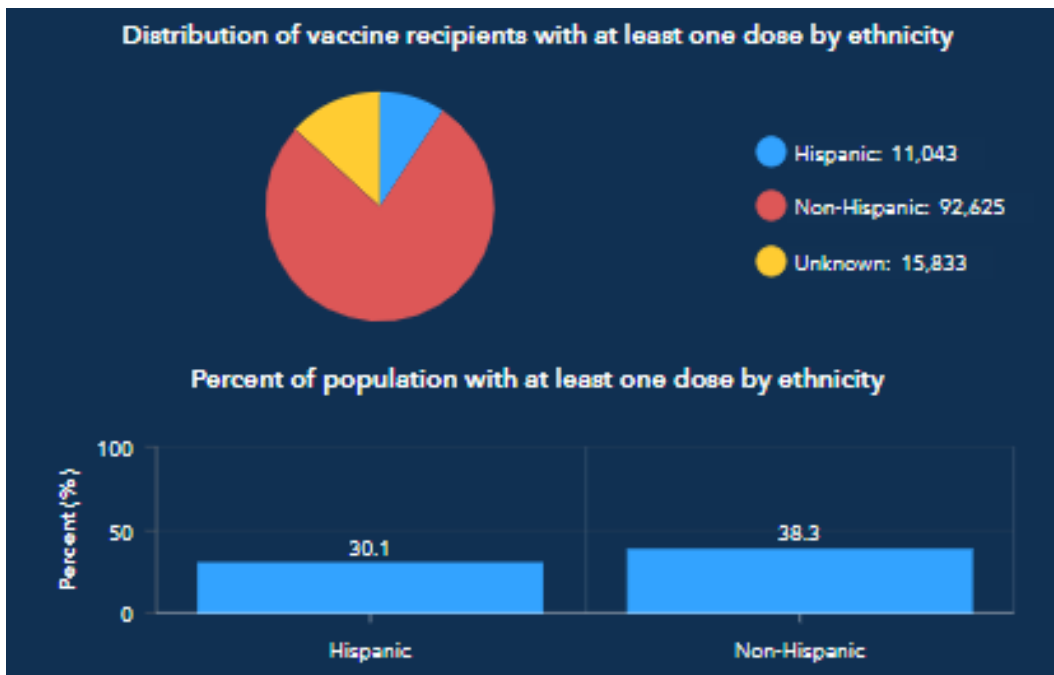

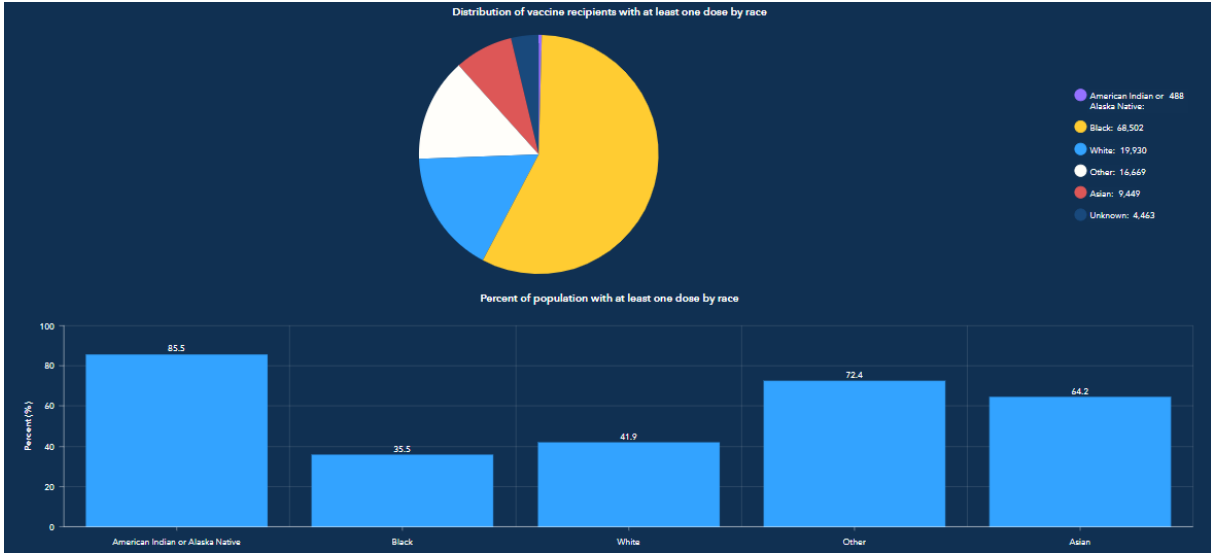
